Visitor centre:

The Visitor Centre was not opened for the 2012 season. Suggestions for its refocus and future use are being considered.

Updates:

- Maplefest did not take place in 2012 as the Chalk River Lions Club was undergoing personnel changes. It is hoped that this annual event will continue in future years as it raises the profile of the PRF and is a major fundraiser for the Chalk River Lions Club.

- Stone Chimney Sign & Plaque: The stone chimney signs and plaque are now in place.
- **Signage:** There are a number of signs still needed by the PRF. The Friends have assisted with this in the past and will continue to pursue this project.
- Ski trail maintenance is ongoing.

Suggestions: There have been a number of interesting suggestions made regarding the Friends' future ongoing participation with the PRF. Some of these include:

- The creation of self-guided tours of the PRF.
- Establishment of an arboretum on the PRF.
- A PRF family ski day.
- New signs for silviculture projects.
- Project T.E.D. (Tree Exchange Depot) is a new incentive to promote reading which
 involves having donated children's books put into depots made from tree trunks and
 placed in locations accessible to readers around the County. Although the PRF is
 probably not a suitable location for a depot due to potential problems with vandalism, the
 Friends could help with the distribution of books, and fallen trees from the station could
 be donated for this project if requested.
- Portions of the PRF database, including vintage maps, are to be uploaded to the Friends' website.

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> As of October 17, 2012. the Friends' account at the Deep River Northern Credit Union stood at **\$3 216.44**. One corporate donation and 23 individual donations were received this year. A GST rebate cheque of \$472.31 was deposited.
